FAA Allows Airlines to Expand Use of Portable Electronics

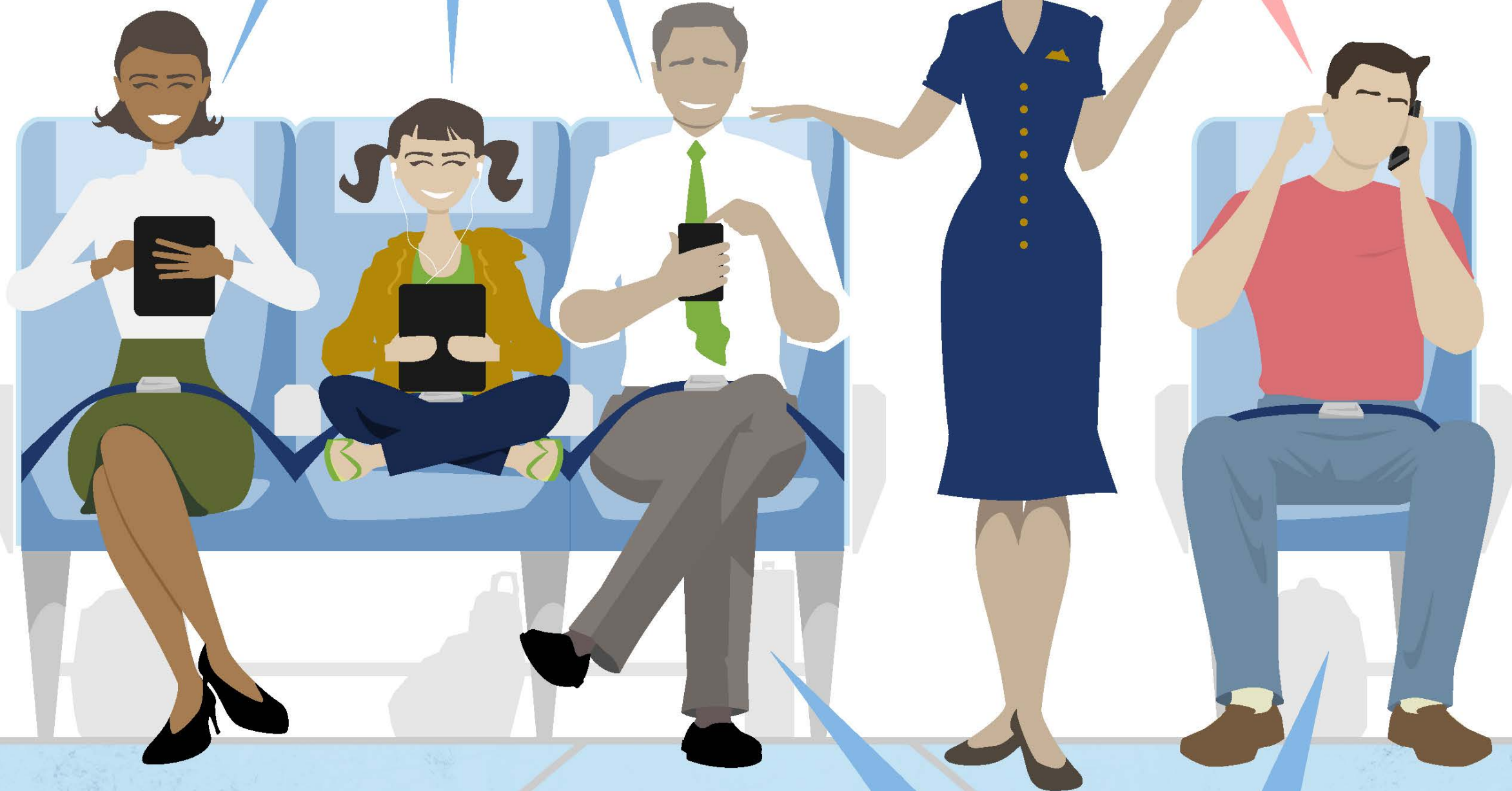
